Access to documents will generally be refused if the reason provided is limited to:

- a general desire to be informed;
- your own personal benefit, unrelated to the best interests of the person who the application is about;
- you are the executor or administrator of a deceased estate; or

offence to provide false or misleading information to SAT.

If your application for documents and or a transcipt is successful, you will receive written confirmation from SAT. You will then need to arrange a time to inspect the documents as copies will not usually be provided.
